DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- 1. Initial dosage for pool water having no visible algae is 70 mL of EQWA CONTRÔLE NOVELCA 60% DESTRUCTIVE ALGAECIDE per 10,000 L of pool water.
- 2. Weekly maintenance dosage is 25 mL of EQWA CONTRÔLE NOVELCA 60% DESTRUCTIVE ALGAECIDE per 10,000 L of pool water.
- 3. For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate following label instructions of superchlorination product employed and wait at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage.
- 4. For visible algae growth, when superchlorination product is not employed, add 100 mL of EQWA CONTRÔLE NOVELCA 60% DESTRUCTIVE ALGAECIDE per 10.000 L of pool water.

PRECAUTIONS
