Pyrithione 40 MUP is sold for use in manufacturing formulations registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*. Formulators are responsible for their own registration of the formulated pest control products.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL
