Place bottom end of stick into ground.

Do not touch glowing end.

Use one mosquito stick per 9m² (100 square feet).

Use in outdoor areas such as backyards, patio, decks, etc. which are sheltered from effects of wind and more easily protected by sticks.

For best results, do not use in windy areas.

To extinguish, gently knock off glowing tip and extinguish tip into dirt or sand. Note: If crack appears in body of sticks, this is normal and in no way impedes its effectiveness.

Remove mosquito stick from box. Ignite tip until it flames. Invert to further ignite body of the stick.

When this occurs, blow out flame.

Place bottom end of stick into ground.

Do not touch glowing end.

Place mosquito sticks about 3 to 3.5 m (10 to 12 feet) apart.

Use one mosquito stick per 9m² (100 square feet).

Use in outdoor areas such as backyards, patio, decks, etc. which are sheltered from effects of wind and more easily protected by sticks.

For best results, do not use in windy areas.

To extinguish, gently knock off glowing tip and extinguish tip into dirt or sand. Note: If crack appears in body of sticks, this is normal and in no way impedes its effectiveness
