For manufacturing use only. TEE-100A is a TECHNICAL for formulating purposes only. Formulators are responsible for their own registrations.

This product should <u>not</u> be used or compounded with any reducing or oxidizing agents (such as calcium hypochlorite, solid perchlorate or nitric acid) since such mixtures may be explosive. Do not use in conjunction with soap or any anionic wetting agent. Wear goggles or face shield, rubber gloves and respirator if mist is generated. PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

FIRST AID:
