DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a product which is registered under the **PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT**.

O-TAC PLANT CONTACT AGENT® may be prepared from **Mascol 80®** by adding 15 parts of an emulsifier (Tween 80) to 85 parts **Mascol 80®** and agitation well for 5 to 10 minutes.

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

Warning. Causes serious eye irritation. Wear suitable protective clothing and gloves (butyl rubber, nitrile rubber). Wear Safety goggles or tightly sealed safety glasses. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or mist. Use with adequate ventilation.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store **MASCOL 80®** container tightly closed in a well ventilated place. **Do not** store together with oxidizing agents. Keep away from source of ignitions.

DISPOSAL: Canadian formulators using the product should dispose of unwanted active and containers in accordance with municipal and provincial regulations. For additional details and clean-up of spills contact the Provincial Regulatory Agency or the Manufacturer.

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferable by mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
