

TIPS:

Ants: Store ant-attractive foods in plastic containers with lids that snap tight. Empty kitchen garbage containers often. Repair and seal as many visible cracks in the foundation and exterior walls of your house as possible. Indoors, caulk along baseboards, cracks and crevices to keep the ants from passing through your house.

Spiders: Sweep behind washers and dryers often and rearrange furniture periodically to avoid spiders spinning webs in the same location. Keep clothing, shoes and blankets off the floor so that spiders do not hide in them during the day.

Wasps: Avoid leaving food or drink uncovered when eating outside. Keep all garbage covered in tightly closed containers until it can be thrown out. Spraying after nightfall is recommended because wasps are less active at night.

Use THIS product to: Kill (bugs) on Contact: Use (This Product) (Raid®Essentials Flying Bug Killer) to kill listed insects on contact.

Use OTHER Raid® products to: Kill (bugs) at the source: For ant problems, use a Raid® Ant Bait product to kill ants where they breed. For spider problems, use Raid® Spider Blaster to kill spiders in the nest on contact. For wasp problems, use Raid® Wasp & Hornet Killer 7 (outdoors) to kill wasps and their entire nests on contact.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE. FOR INDOOR USE:

This product is ready to use. Always shake before use. Hold can upright while spraying.

Within the specified use location, to enhance effectiveness of this product, apply directly to listed pests where possible. For all labelled uses, treatment must only be repeated after 7 days if the pest problem persists or reoccurs. Good sanitary practices should be maintained to prevent re-infestation.

USE LIMITATIONS: Ventilate treated areas after application by opening windows and doors or using fans, where required, to aid in the circulation of air. **DO NOT** apply when people or pets are present. **DO NOT** allow people or pets to enter treated areas until sprays have settled. **DO NOT** remain in treated areas after application. Cover or remove all food/feed. Cover all food/feed processing surfaces, equipment and utensils or thoroughly wash them following treatment. Any food/feed accidentally contaminated with spray solution must be discarded.

HOW TO APPLY: APPLY AS A SPACE SPRAY ONLY. <u>Space application</u> is a suspension of fine droplets in the air within an indoor space.

SPACE APPLICATION:

To kill mosquitoes, flies, and wasps: Close all windows and doors and shut off all ventilating systems and sources of ignition before treatment. Shake before using. While holding can at arm's length, spray Raid® Essentials Flying Bug Killer upward (in a sweeping motion) to all parts of the room, especially the ceiling, upper corners of the room, windows and other light sources. Keep spray at least 1m from interior walls, fabrics and furniture. Begin application at the far side of the room and work backwards toward the exit. DO NOT exceed the max spray rate of 10-11 seconds per average room (30m³). Vacate the treated area and keep windows and doors closed for 15 minutes, then ventilate for 15 minutes before re-entry.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Cover fishbowls when spraying rooms. **DO NOT** inhale the product. KEEP FROM FREEZING. CONTENTS UNDER PRESSURE. **DO NOT** puncture or incinerate the container. **DO NOT** place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources heat.

FIRST AID: If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. DO NOT induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. DO NOT give any liquid to the person. DO NOT give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If inhaled, move the person to fresh air. If the person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. Take the container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical
