DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

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Suspension concentrate to be used only for the manufacture of an end-use product registered under the Pest Control Products Act for management of *Cydia pomonella* and *Grapholita molestra* populations.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. May irritate eyes. May cause sensitization. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. For good hygienic practice, wear chemical resistant gloves and coveralls when handling this product.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control centre or a doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferable by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or a doctor for further treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or a doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Treat symptomatically.

STORAGE:

Store in original container. CpGV V-22 Technical should be used within 2 years from the date of manufacture when stored at or below 5°C.

DISPOSAL:

Canadian manufacturers should dispose of unwanted active ingredients and containers in accordance with municipal and provincial regulations. For additional details and clean-up of spills, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency.
