### **PRECAUTIONS:**

### **Polymer Latex Emulsions:**

Add 1000 g to 3000 g of Preventol BM 5 to each 1000 kg of product (1000 - 3000 ppm)

## **Household, Institutional, and Industrial Cleaning Products:**

Add 500 g to 1200 g of Preventol BM 5 to each 1000 kg of product (500 - 1200 ppm)

### **Pesticide Products:**

Add 500 g to 1200 g of Preventol BM 5 to each 1000 kg of product (500 - 1200 ppm)
