TCMTB-DPM is for use in manufacturing, formulating or repackaging. It is to be used only for the manufacture of industrial microbicides which are registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*.

PRECAUTIONS

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL

Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not breathe the mists. Low concentration of airborne aerosols are likely to cause respiratory and skin irritation. When handling the concentrate, we are full face protection with cartridge respirator and impermeable gloves, aprons and boots. Use only in well ventilated area. Do not wear contact lenses.

FIRST AID

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing : Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If ingested: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

STORAGE
