DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- 1. Initial dosage of **MAX ALGAE SHIELD 50** for pool water having no visible algae is 80 ml of **MAX ALGAE SHIELD 50** per 10,000 L of pool water.
- 2. Weekly maintenance dosage is 30 ml per 10,000 L. of pool water.
- 3. For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate following label instructions of superchlorination product employed and wait for at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage.
- 4. For visible algae growth, when superchlorination is not employed, add 120 ml of **MAX ALGAE SHIELD 50** per 10,000L of pool water.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed. Do not mix with any other chemical. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

DISPOSAL:
