ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS: Toxic to non-target terrestrial plants. Avoid application when windy. **DO NOT** apply to the point of runoff. Avoid application when heavy rain is forecast. **DO NOT** apply to any body of water. **DO NOT** contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

FIRST AID:

PRODUCT INFORMATION:

This product is for use as a spot treatment on residential lawns for control or suppression or partial suppression of several broadleaf weeds and moss.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

This is a ready-to-use product for spot treatment on residential lawns. The application should be carefully directed to the weeds, while minimizing contact with the surrounding turf. To avoid staining, do not spray on interlocks, driveways, patios, or near fences. Do not allow people or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.

Apply when weeds are young and actively growing.

Spray when the air temperature is between 10°C (50°F) and 26°C (80°F). When temperatures exceed 26°C (80°F), potential injury to turf grass increases if there is any contact with the surrounding turf.

Weeds begin to die after 1-2 days. It may take several weeks for some weeds to completely die. If necessary, repeat application after two or more weeks.

Weeds Controlled: Annual Sow Thistle, Black medic, Broadleaved Plantain, Canada Thistle (season-long control), Common Groundsel, Dandelion, and Ground Ivy.

Weeds Suppressed: Moss and White Clover.

Weeds Partially Suppressed: Common Ragweed and Narrowleaved Plantain.

All applications should be made according to the application procedures that follow.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

This product is ready-to-use. Do not mix or dilute with water.

Application Instructions

- Shake well before use.
- Rotate nozzle to spray position.
- Adjust nozzle to provide desired spray pattern.
- Hold spray about 30 cm (12 inches) from weed.
- Spray weeds until foliage is thoroughly wetted. DO NOT apply to the point of runoff.
- Rotate nozzle to closed position when not in use.

Use Precautions

- DO NOT apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet, either directly or through drift.
- DO NOT allow people or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.
- Avoid drift of spray mist onto vegetables, flowers, ornamental plants, shrubs, trees, and other desirable plants. Avoid application in windy conditions.
- DO NOT spray exposed roots of ornamentals and trees.
- Rain within 8 hours reduces effectiveness. Avoid irrigation for at least 8 hours after application.
- DO NOT apply when the lawn is under severe stress from drought, insect attack or high temperatures.
- Delay mowing for 1-2 days before and after application.
- If the lawn is dry, water 24 hours before using this product.
- DO NOT apply to new grass seedlings or new sod until mowed at least three times. DO NOT apply to driveways, sidewalks, interlocks or any other hard surface.
- If used inappropriately, any pest control product, including those with natural ingredients, may have health, safety or environmental risks: use this product only in accordance with label instructions.

Optional Text for formulations that include the colourants: Product contains colorant. Wear water-proof gloves to avoid staining during application. Wait until treated area thoroughly dries before re-entry. Typically dries after 2-3 hours, depending on weather conditions – slowest dry times typically occur under high humidity low temperature conditions.

IMPORTANT: Certain grasses vary in tolerance to this product. Temporary discoloration may occur and grass typically recovers in 2-3 weeks. If unsure of grass sensitivity, test spray a small area of your lawn first.

STORAGE:

Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put into food or drink containers. Store in a cool, dry place, in a locked storage area. Store this product away from food or feed.

Do not allow to freeze.

DISPOSAL:

DO NOT reuse empty container. Dispose in household garbage. Unused or partially used products should be disposed at provincially or municipally designated hazardous waste disposal sites.

NOTICE TO USER:

This pest control product is to be used only in accordance with the directions on the label. It is an offence under the Pest Control Products Act to use this product in a way that is inconsistent with the directions on the label.
