DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

This product is to be used only in the manufacture of a product which is registered under the *PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT*.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Fatal or poisonous if swallowed. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Do not breathe dust. Do not contaminate feed or food. Wash hands, arms, and face thoroughly with soap and warm water before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically. This compound does not cause any definite symptoms that would be diagnostic of poisoning. Poisoning is accompanied by breathing difficulties and sedation.

FIRST AID:

Obtain prompt medical aid or contact a poison control centre IMMEDIATELY if poisoning should occur. Remove victim to safe, uncontaminated area. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

- IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.
- IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.
- IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

DISPOSAL:

Canadian manufacturers should dispose of unwanted active ingredients and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations. For additional details and clean-up of spills, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency.

STORAGE:

Store in a cool, dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food, and feed. Store in original container and out of the reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area.

Handle open container in a manner as to prevent spillage. If the container is leaking or material spilled for any reason or cause, carefully sweep material into a pile. Refer to Precautionary Statements on label for hazards associated with the handling of this material. Do not walk-through spilled material. Dispose of pesticide in accordance with municipal and provincial regulations. In spill or leak incidents, keep unauthorized people away.
