DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

ANTLER SURFACTANT is only to be used in a tank-mix with the post-emergence herbicide TRIGGER for control of grass weeds, volunteer cereals and quackgrass in seedling alfalfa, dry beans (Pinto, Black, Great Northern, Red, Pink and Navy), canola, Desi and Kabuli chickpeas, flax (including low linolenic acid varieties), field peas, lentils, mustard (oriental, brown, yellow) (condiment type only), dry onions, potatoes, soybeans, and sunflowers.

ANTLER SURFACTANT is to be used at 0.5% v/v - 1.0% v/v with the recommended rate of TRIGGER as specified on the product label.

PRECAUTIONS:

WARNING: Causes severe eye and skin irritation.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wear long sleeved shirt, long pants during all activities and goggles, face shield and chemical resistant gloves during mixing, loading, clean up and repair activities. Wash concentrate from skin or eyes immediately. Avoid breathing vapours or spray mist. Avoid working in spray mist. After use, wash hands and other exposed skin thoroughly. Store the container tightly closed away from seeds, fertilizer, plants and foodstuffs. Avoid contamination of ponds, streams, rivers and other water sources.

FIRST AID:

If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.
