DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacturing, formulating or repackaging of a pest control product registered under the Pest Control Products Act.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL: Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly after using or before eating, drinking or smoking. Wear clean protective clothing, including chemical resistant gloves, goggles and respirator when handling manufacturing product.

FIRST AID:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label, or product name and Pest

Control Product Registration number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Treat symptomatically. Medical personnel should contact 911.

STORAGE:

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Store tightly sealed original container in a cool, dry area away from feed, seeds, plants and foodstuffs.

TOXIC to aquatic organisms.
