## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To be used only in the manufacture of a herbicide which is registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*.

## FIRST AID

**If swallowed:** Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**If on skin or clothing:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

**If inhaled:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

**If in eyes:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

## TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Dicamba may cause severe irritation to the eyes and irritation to the skin and mucous membranes. Symptoms of overexposure to dicamba may include dizziness, muscle weakness, loss of appetite, weight loss, vomiting, decreased heart rate, shortness of breath, excitement, tenseness, depression, incontinence, cyanosis, muscle spasms, exhaustion and loss of voice. Treat symptomatically. The physical properties of the test material precluded administration at high atmospheric concentrations. Not a skin irritant (DOT method). Skin irritation may occur when handling finely ground material. Extremely irritating and corrosive to the eye (FHSA).

## PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND/OR PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. It is extremely irritating and corrosive to the eye. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing.

Wear protective goggles when handling.

## ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS

TOXIC to aquatic organisms and non-target terrestrial plants. DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

## STORAGE

Store in original container in a well-ventilated, cool, dry, and secure area. Ship and store away from food, feed, seed, fertilizers, insecticides or fungicides. Do not use or store product near heat or open flame.

## FIRE EXTINGUISHING MEDIA

Fog or water spray, foam, carbon dioxide.

## SPECIAL FIRE FIGHTING PROCEDURES

In case of severe fire, full protective clothing and self-contained breathing apparatus should be worn. Decomposition products are hazardous to health. Use water to keep fire-exposed containers cool. First opportunity, remove from fire.
