PRECAUTIONS

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.

FIRST AID PROCEDURES

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

STORAGE

Absorb the liquid onto soil, sawdust or other suitable absorbent material and shovel into a drum. Add broken packages to the drum and seal for removal to an approved disposal site. Wash spill site with water and mop up into a drum for disposal to an approved disposal site. Remove and wash all protective clothing and equipment.
