DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Use Preventol A8 II Technical Fungicide to formulate wood preservatives registered under the *PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT*. To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the *PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT*. Labelling for products formulated from Preventol A8 II Technical Fungicide must conform to the *PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT*.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling and before eating, drinking or smoking. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse.

FIRST AID:

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
