PRECAUTIONS: PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Formulators and other handlers must wear long sleeved shirt, long pants, chemical resistant gloves, and shoes plus socks. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before re-use. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

## **FIRST AID**

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor IMMEDIATELY for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. DO NOT induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. DO NOT give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin IMMEDIATELY with plenty of water for 15 – 20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: No specific antidote is available. Treat the patient symptomatically.

ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS: Toxic to aquatic organisms.

DO NOT discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems, lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. DO NOT store in direct sunlight. DO NOT allow prolonged storage in temperatures that exceed 40°C or in temperatures that fall below -10°C.
