DIRECTIONS FOR USE: To be used in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the **PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT**. Read Technical Bulletin for formulation details.

PRECAUTIONS: PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Fatal if swallowed. May irritate the skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Potential skin sensitizer. Formulators and other handlers must wear coveralls over a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, chemical-resistant gloves, socks and shoes. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or smoking. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing. Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

FIRST AID: Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention. If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If inhaled, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Contains petroleum distillates – vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Treat symptomatically.

ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS: This product contains active ingredients and aromatic petroleum distillates, which are toxic to aquatic organisms. Toxic to non-target terrestrial plants. DO NOT contaminate aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste.
