TURF:

OVERALL APPLICATION: For the control of chinch bugs, earwigs, ticks, ants, lawn moth (sod webworm), crickets, grasshoppers, brown dog ticks, chiggers, clover mites, pillbugs, fleas, sow bugs, millipedes and springtails (collembola), apply 95 - 196 kg/ha or 975 g - 2 kg per 100 m2. Do not water lawns for 2 days after application. Application can be made by hand with a shaker can or using a fertilizer spreader. Repeat the application as necessary. Following application, brush the lawn to ensure penetration of the granules on the soil surface.

WHITE GRUBS (Larvae of European Chafer and Japanese Beetle): Apply 1.5 kg per 100 m2 of lawn. Water grass thoroughly after application. For grub control apply any time between late July and early October.

LEATHER JACKETS (B.C. only): Apply 750 g per 100 m2 of lawn between early October and late May when the soil is not frozen. Water lawn thoroughly after treatment.
