Kartridges are for use in solution in the Killer Kane to selectively spot-kill dandelions, plantain and other broadleaved weeds in lawns.

HOW TO USE: Remove cap from "Killer Kane" and fill with water (550 mL). Drop in one kartridge - replace cap and allow kartridge to dissolve completely. Adjust nozzle for desired spray size - push down tip of "Kane" on weed - release quickly, wetting weeds thoroughly. After using rinse "Kane" with clear water.

WHEN TO USE: Apply to young and actively growing weeds when weather is clear and warm (15 C to 25 C) and several days of clear weather are forecast. Do not mow or water lawn for several days after application. Killing action starts when weeds begin to twist but complete kill may take several weeks. Certain resistant weeds may require a repeat application after three weeks.

CAUTION: May damage bent grass, clovers or broadleaved ground covers. Do not use on newly seeded grass until after the second mowing.

PRECAUTIONS: Keep out of reach of children. Do not contaminate food or water supplies. Store with vial tightly closed away for pets, valuable plants, seeds and fertilizers. Avoid swallowing or contact with eyes, skin or clothing.

## PROTECTIVE CLOTHING

Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks and shoes.

OPERATOR USE PRECAUTIONS

- Wash hands before eating, drinking, using tobacco or using the toilet.
- After treating, wash thoroughly.

- If pesticide penetrates clothing, remove immediately; then wash contaminated skin thoroughly and shower. Launder contaminated clothing separately before reuse.

RE-ENTRY INTERVAL

Do not allow people (other than the applicator) or pets on the treatment area during application. Do not enter treated areas until spray has thoroughly dried.

FIRST AID: If on skin, wash with soap and water. If in eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes and get medical attention. If swallowed, induce vomiting immediately and get medical attention, or contact a poison control centre.
