DIRECTIONS: To control wasps, hornets, bees and yellow jackets. 1. Shake can well before using. 2. Remove protective cap. 3. Insert plastic tube into spray nozzle. 4. Direct the tube at the target insect nest. 5. Press the nozzle and from a distance of 2-2.5 metres (6-8 feet) completely cover the nest with foam. The insects will now be trapped in the nest. 6. Insert the applicator wand into the nest opening and fill the nest with insecticide foam. Allow sufficient time for insects to become inactive before destroying the nest. Application to nests should be made in late evening or early morning when insects are at rest. LIMITATIONS: Do NOT use inside homes, on humans or animals. Do NOT use as a space spray. PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Provide adequate ventilation of areas being treated. Avoid contact with

skin, eyes and clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after using. Toxic to bees, fish and wildlife. Do not contaminate any body of water. Do not contaminate animal feeding areas. Contents under pressure. Do not store or use above 50'C as container may burst. Do not puncture or incinerate container. FIRST AID: If on skin, wash immediately with soap and warm water. If in eyes, flush for 15 minutes with water. If irritation develops, consult physician. If accidentally swallowed, obtain medical attention or call poison control centre at once. TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine sulfate is antidotal. Do not give morphine. Watch for delayed pulmonary edema in cases of serious poisoning. In this case, use oxygen therapy and treat symptomatically. DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press button to release all pressure. Do not throw into fire. Wrap and dispose with household garbage.
