DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL INFORMATION.

HOT FOOT Bird Repellent is a soft, sticky material. It remains tacky all year round and will repel birds for periods exceeding one year under average conditions. Use on roofs, window sills, chimneys, cornices, peaks of buildings, office buildings and residential buildings.

DIRECTIONS: Apply HOT FOOT to clean, dry surfaces where birds roost, ensure that surfaces are clean and dry by wiping or

scraping off all dust, dirt, loose paint, droppings, etc. Apply a strip approximately 8 mm wide and 8 mm thick about 1.5 cm from the outer edge or along the highest point. On wide areas 2 or more such strips spaced 10 cm apart may be required. If prompt removal is anticipated. Applications can be made on waterproof masking tape. Solvents such as Mineral Spirits may be used for cleaning hands and tools. Dispose of empty container in garbage.
