# DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1) Cooling Water Systems: For the control of algae, bacteria, and fungi in commercial and Industrial cooling water systems, add product as follows:

Initial dose: 20 - 120 mL per 1,000 L water in the system. Maintenance dose: Every 1 to 5 days or as needed, 6.4 - 40 mL per 1,000 L of water in the system.
