DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Mix thoroughly one part of this CONCENTRATE with 19 parts by weight of a cereal type bait material such as corn meal, and/or rolled oats. A small amount of an edible oil, such as mineral corn or peanut oil, may be used up to 3% to prevent dusting or to increase acceptability.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Use finished bait to control the Norway rat (Rattus norvegicus), roof rat (Rattus rattus) and house mouse (Mus musculus) indoors and against the outside walls of dwellings, farm buildings, food service establishments (non-food areas), granary bins (empty), processing plants (feed and food, in non-food areas), and storage areas (non-food). **Food Processing, Food Manufacturing, Food Storage, and Food Service Areas:** For areas not directly related to food processing: Use only in non-food or non-feed area where feed, food, packaging and handling equipment are never opened or exposed. For areas where feed or food is processed, served or stored: In meat

and food processing plants (processing areas), use only when plant is not in operation. Remove or cover all food, packaging material and utensils before placing bait in baiting stations. Remove all baits and dead rodents before reuse of the plant (processing areas include storage and service). Users should remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash skin thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

GENERAL: Place finished bait in locations frequented by the rodents, such as tunnels, feeding areas and runways. For rats, place 100 - 500g of bait per station. For mice, set out about 50g of bait at intervals of 2 - 3m. Maintain an uninterrupted supply until feeding ceases.

USE LIMITATIONS: Bait MUST either be placed in tamper-resistant bait stations or in locations not accessible to children, pets or livestock. DO NOT place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

To ensure safe use of this product, tamper-resistant bait stations must have the following characteristics:

- * constructed of high-strength material (e.g., metal or injection moulded plastic) and resistant to destruction by children and non-target animals;
- * entrance designed so that children and non-target animals cannot reach the bait;
- * internal structure that prevents bait from being shaken loose;
- * access panel that fastens securely and locks (e.g. metal screw or padlock);
- * capable of being securely fastened to a surface (e.g. nailed down); and
- * clearly labelled: "WARNING POISON".

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN, PETS AND LIVESTOCK.

If ingested, this material may reduce clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. May be harmful or fatal if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Chemical-resistant gloves must be worn when handling product and when disposing of dead rodents, unconsumed bait and empty containers. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Wash contaminated clothing, separately from other laundry, with soap and water before reuse. KEEP AWAY FROM FEED AND FOODSTUFFS. Do not contaminate any body of water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing and inhalation of powder.

All handlers must wear long-sleeved shirt and long pants, shoes plus socks, and chemical resistant gloves. Wear a NIOSH-approved particulate-filter respirator and protective eyewear while pouring and mixing the concentrate with bait. Users should remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash skin thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, give patient one or two glasses of water and INDUCE VOMITING by touching back of throat with finger or blunt object; repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. For all cases of human ingestion, immediately notify a physician or poison control centre.

If a pet or livestock poisoning is suspected, immediately contact a veterinarian. If in eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes. **If on skin**, wash with soap and water. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Vitamin K₁ in the form of intramuscular or subcutaneous injections or by oral ingestion are suggested remedial treatments for anticoagulant poisoning. The severity of the case measured by establishing prolonged prothrombin times (P.T.) will determine appropriate therapy. Monitoring P.T. will indicate the necessity of repeated treatments.

NOTICE TO USER: This pest control product is to be used only in accordance with the directions on the label. It is an offence under the *Pest Control Products Act* to use this product in a way that is inconsistent with the directions on the label. The user assumes the risk to persons or property that arises from any such use of this product.

STORAGE: Keep in original container during storage. Store in cool, dry place away from other chemicals and food or feed. Store product not in use, in original container, in a secure location inaccessible to children and non-target animals. Keep away from fire, flame or other source of heat.

DECONTAMINATION AND DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Dispose of unused or spoiled bait in accordance with local requirements. Make container unsuitable for further use. Follow provincial regulations for any required cleaning of the container prior to its disposal. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements. For information on disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency in case of spilling, and for clean-up of spills.
