DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Proper application of DIACIDE 938 depends on many factors, such as system design and severity of the problem. Feed DIACIDE 938 to injection water at 25-100 ppm (continuous treatment) or at 100-500 ppm (intermittent treatment) or as required to establish control.

PRECAUTIONS: HARMFUL OR FATAL IF SWALLOWED

Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get into eyes, or skin or clothing. Wear goggles or face mask and rubber gloves when handling. Wash thoroughly after handling. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.
