Apply by wiping, mopping or scrubbing, thoroughly wetting the surface with the recommended use dilution.

ENOL PLUS has been proven effective against Staphylococcus

aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, Pseudomonas, Trichophyton mentagrophytes and Mycobacterium tuberculosis. AOAC use dilution tests were conducted in hard water (200 ppm as CaCO<sub>3</sub>)

DIRECTIONS: Dilute 13 ML of ENOL PLUS per litre of potable water (1:80)

Surfaces subject to direct food contact should be adequately rinsed with potable water.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:
