SANITIZING OF FOOD PROCESSING EQUIPMENT AND OTHER HARD SURFACES  
IN FOOD CONTACT LOCATIONS.

For sanitizing food processing equipment, dairy equipment, food  
utensils, dishes, silverware, glasses, sink tops, countertops,  
refrigerated storage and display equipment and other hard  
non-porous surfaces. No potable rinse in required.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Wash and rinse all articles thoroughly, the  
apply a solution of 2 ml AB-787 in 1 liter of water (150 ppm  
active). Surfaces should remain wet for at least 1 minute  
followed by adequate draining and air drying. Fresh solution  
should be prepared daily or when use solution becomes visibly  
dirty. For mechanical application, use solution may not be reused  
for sanitizing applications.

Apply to sink tops, counter tops, refrigerated storage and display equipment and other stationary hard surfaces by cloth, brush, or mechanical spray device. No potable water rinse is required.

Dishes, silverware, glasses, cooking utensils and other similar size food processing equipment can be sanitized by immersion in a 2 ml/L solution of AB-787. No potable rinse is required.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. DANGER - Corrosive to eyes. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately or poison control center.
