INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

RID-A-BIRD must be used only in RID-A-BIRD perches. Do not use as a surface treatment. This ready to use concentrate is packaged in a dispenser bottle with proper pour spout, especially designed to engage RID-A-BIRD solution into the fill hole on the RID-A-BIRD perch. Fill until wick is saturated, but do not over fill. Use care to avoid spillage. Wear rubber gloves when servicing the perch.

RESTRICTIONS FOR APPLICATORS:

For use only by persons trained in bird control work. Local, provincial and federal permits must be obtained by the user prior to bird control operations. Birds killed must be picked up, buried or burned.

NOTICE TO USER:

This control product is to be used only in accordance with the directions on this label. It is an offence under the Pest Control Products Act to use a control product under unsafe conditions.

NATURE OF RESTRICTION:

This product to be used only by qualified pest control operators.

DIRECTIONS: (Refer to Instructions for Installations of RID-A-BIRD Perch) to control Starlings, House Sparrows and Pigeons in Processing plants (non food), Processing Plant (Feed, food) in non food storage area; Outdoor areas (Loading docks, garbage sites, bridges, in and around farming buildings (storage area -non food).

TOXICOLOGY INFORMATION:

Administer atropine sulfate in large therapeutic doses. Repeat as necessary to the point of tolerance. Liberal doses of glucose to enhance the antidotal properties of atropine, in case of poisoning.

PRECAUTION

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. If spilled on skin, wash immediately with soap and warm water after handling and before eating or smoking. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse.

CALL PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.

FIRST AID TREATMENT:

Have patient lie down and keep quiet. If swallowed, induce vomiting by give a tablespoon of salt in glass of warm water.

Do no apply or allow to drift in areas occupied by humans or beneficial animals.

Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs.

Destroy container when empty.

ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS:

RID-A-BIRD concentrate will kill fish if accidentally discharged into fish bearing waters. Non-target birds and wild life coming into contact with RID-A-BIRD perches, with RID-A-BIRD concentrate in it, will be killed or injured. Bird and wildlife food or feed must be kept away from treated areas to minimize hazard to them.

Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.
