**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

To be used only in the manufacture of a herbicide that is registered under the Pest Control Products Act or in the formulation of Weed and Feed Lawn and Turf Fertilizers. Read the technical bulletin for formulation details.

**PRECAUTIONS:**

Harmful if swallowed. May cause skin and eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wear chemical resistant goggles and gloves when handling. Wash hands and

exposed skin thoroughly after handling.

**FIRST AID INSTRUCTIONS:**
