PURPOSE: Sergeant's Household Flea Killer for spot treatment has a residual that will last 1-2 weeks. This spray is specifically formulated for use by pet owners as a quick-killing, economical way to control fleas and ticks where your pet sleeps and plays. Use on bedding, sleeping quarters, on carpets and upholstery where they may hide and breed. Spray these areas as needed. Repeat treatment is usually necessary. Also kills spiders, earwigs, cockroaches, crickets, millipedes, silverfish, ants and carpet beetles.

DIRECTIONS: Shake can well. Remove cap. Hold can upright to spray. Test a small inconspicuous area of fabric, carpet or

wall covering for colour fastness and staining. Point nozzle toward surface to be treated and apply evenly. Spot treat bedding and resting quarters, nearby cracks, crevices, along baseboards, windows, door frames, floors, carpets and upholstery where pests may be present. Replace pets bedding material or wash immediately after treatment. Treat dogs and cats with Sergeant's flea and tick products before allowing them to reenter treated areas. DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT. KEEP PETS AND CHILDREN AWAY FROM TREATED SURFACE UNTIL DRY.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat or store at temperatures over 50°C. Do not spray near flame or spark. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash hands after use. DO NOT USE ON HUMANS, PLANTS, ANIMALS, FOODSTUFF, FOOD UTENSILS, FISH BOWLS OR ANIMAL FEED AREAS. DO NOT USE AS A SPACE SPRAY OR NEAR KITCHEN COUNTERS, CUPBOARDS OR ANY OTHER PLACE WHERE FOOD MAY BE CONTAMINATED.

FIRST AID TREATMENT: Contains volatile petroleum distillate. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call physician immediately. Propoxur is a mild cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. In case of contact with skin, wash with soap and water. If in eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes, seek medical attention.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press button to release all pressure, then discard with household garbage. Do not puncture or incinerate.
