Kills grubs, chinch bugs, ants, sod webworms, spiders, earwigs, sowbugs, cutworms, crickets and other garden pests.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Apply MASTERCRAFT Hose-Spray Liquid Lawn Insect Control using the hose-end sprayer attached which will accurately dilute this concentrated insecticide. Contents will cover up to 400 square metres (4320 square feet) of lawn and garden area.

Simply attach sprayer to your garden hose and follow these simple instructions.

Read the complete label for applications and precautions.

- 1) Shake well before applications.
- 2) Make sure the hose-end sprayer is firmly connected to the hose.
- 3) Turn water supply on at the source. Water pressure will build in hose since the sprayer is already in the "OFF" position.
- 4) Remove the safety ring from the control valve on the side of the sprayer. The safety ring may either remain on or be removed from the sprayer.
- 5) To apply product, turn the control valve clockwise to the "ON" position.
- 6) For best results, hold sprayer and bottle level, and direct sprayer in a sweeping side-to-side movement.
- 7) To spray water only, turn the control valve clockwise so that the valve indicator arrow is pointing to the "WATER" position on the sprayer.
- 8) When spraying is complete, turn the control valve to "OFF" position and reconnect safety ring to control valve. Turn water off. Disconnect hose from applicator and store product in original container.

Thoroughly rinse applicator and store out of reach of children.

APPLICATION: TURF & LAWNS. Make no more than two applications per season. WHITE GRUBS, grubs of EUROPEAN CHAFER and JAPANESE BEETLE apply 500 mL (one-half of contents) evenly over 100 square metres (1080 square ft.) of lawn area. IMMEDIATELY AFTER SPRAYING WATER LAWN THOROUGHLY TO MOVE THE PRODUCT THROUGH THE SOD AND INTO THE SOIL. Best applied in late July and August when grubs are small and feeding on grass roots just below soil surface.

CHINCH BUGS, ANTS, SOD WEBWORMS, CRANE FLY LARVAE (Leatherjackets), MOSQUITOES, spray 500 mL (one-half of contents) evenly over 200 square metres (2160 square ft.) of lawn area.

Apply when these insects first appear and repeat when needed. The lawn surface should be moist before treatment. For sod webworm delay watering or mowing for 12 to 24 hours after treatment. For leatherjackets apply in the late fall after the flight of adult crane flies has ceased for the year.

CAUTION: Rate of delivery of product will vary depending on water pressure, location, time of day, length and diameter of hose, etc. Complete contents of container (1 L) can be sprayed in approximately 3 to 5 minutes.

ORNAMENTAL GARDENS: Make no more than two applications per season. To control ants, crickets, earwigs, sowbugs, spiders, cutworms, white grubs, European chafer larvae and Japanese beetle larvae, spray soil around plants to give good coverage at the rate of 500 mL (one half of contents) per 200 square metres (2160 square ft). For smaller areas spray 125 mL (1/8 of contents) over 50 square metres (540 square ft).

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. May be fatal if swallowed. May be absorbed through the skin. May be injurious to eyes and skin. Wash hands and exposed skin after spraying, also any contaminated clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Do not permit pets to contact spray areas until dry. Do not contaminate food, feed or water; product is poisonous to fish. Re-close container tightly after use and store away from heat.

FIRST AID: Product contains petroleum distillates; if swallowed.

DO NOT induce vomiting but rush patient to hospital, taking this labelled container with you. If in eyes, flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes, and get medical aid. If on skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor; atropine by injection only is antidotal.

DISPOSAL: Discard empty container with household garbage. Do not re-use container.
