DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Use only as directed on this label. Shake before use. Hold container upright. Apply in short bursts.

INDOORS: To kill flies, mosquitoes, flying moths, gnats, wasps and hornets: Space spray: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into centre of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 1 hour after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Before spraying, cover or remove exposed food and utensils.

TO KILL COCKROACHES, ANTS AND CRICKETS: Spot treatment: Contact as many insects as possible the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and whenever these pests are suspected of hiding. For control of ants, treat doors, window sills, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary for control. To kill exposed forms of confused flour beetles, saw-toothed grain beetles and rice weevils: Find and destroy infested packaged goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SOWBUGS, EARWIGS, FIREBRATS AND SPIDERS: Spot treatment: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

TO KILL FLEAS AND TICKS: Remove all pets from home before spraying. Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray all areas suspected of harbouring these pests, including animal bed frames, cracks and crevices, baseboards, spots of floor covering, and under beds. Pets should be treated with a registered control product for fleas and ticks before re-entering home. Do not spray this product directly on animals.

OUTDOORS: TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS AND FLYING MOTHS: Spray area infested with these listed flying insects. Follow precautions listed above. Hold container 45-60 centimetres from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow, sweeping motion at a rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic metre of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these pests, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as

necessary.

TO PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS: For insects on asters, azaleas, begonias, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphinia, gladioli, irises, marigolds, petunias, roses and snapdragons. Also, for insects specified below on evergreens and small ornamental deciduous trees, shrubs and vines. Do not spray cucumbers or other food crops. When sprayed directly on insects, this spray kills sucking insects: Aphids, leafhoppers, spotted mites, thrips (exposed), squash bugs, mealybugs and lace bugs.

KILLS CHEWING INSECTS: Armyworm larvae, Mexican bean beetles, climbing cutworms, eastern tent caterpillar, and Japanese beetles when sprayed directly. When spraying, keep can 45 to 60 centimetres from plant. For best results, spray in evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Use slow sweeping motion. Avoid wetting foliage with the spray. Spray rows at the rate of 30 centimetres per second. For heavy growth, spray row on both sides. Repeat when needed. Spray with caution on young plants and new growth. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 32°C. This product may be used outside on porches, patios and in the yard and picnic areas to kill flies, mosquitoes, gnats and flying moths present at the time of treatment. Spray with the breeze allowing the spray to drift into shrubbery and other places where insects harbour. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL WASPS AND HORNETS: Spray nests with a generous blast (at least 4-6 seconds) from this unit from a distance of approximately 60 centimetres - soaking the nest thoroughly with the spray. To avoid being stung, make applications at dusk, or other times when wasps or hornets are not active.

TO KILL SOWBUGS AND ANTS: Spray directly as many insects as possible. Spray ant hills and trails. Repeat as necessary for control.

PRECAUTIONS: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapours. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Do not use in commercial food processing, storage, preparation or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover or remove exposed food. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquaria before spraying. Do not use this product on any edible crop. This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, ponds or streams. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 50°C may cause bursting.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water. If in eyes, flush with clean water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists, consult a physician. If accidentally swallowed, obtain medical attention at once.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press valve to release all pressure. Wrap container and put in garbage collection.

STORAGE: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.
