DIRECTIONS FOR USE: A heavy duty commercial insecticide for use as an injection system or a space spray (fogging) in hospitals, restaurants, food plants, supermarkets, motels, hotels,

utilities, barns, drive sheds, locker rooms, and industrial buildings. May also be used in homes when applied by professional pest control operators.

SPACE SPRAY (FOGGING): FLYING INSECTS, FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, AND FRUIT FLIES: Close all windows and doors and direct fog upward at a rate of 1-3 seconds per 30 cu.m. Disperse in all locations. Keep area closed for 15 minutes. Ventilate before reentering. Mud Dauber and Wasp Nests: Spray directly on insects and their nests.

CONTACT SPRAY: GRAIN WEEVILS, FLOUR BEETLES, SAWTOOTHED GRAIN BEETLE, CHOCOLATE MOTHS, INDIAN MEAL MOTHS, CARPET BEETLES, DRUG STORE BEETLES IN EXPOSED ADULT AND LARVAE STAGES: Contact as many insects as possible when treating infested areas such as cracks, crevices, stored products, machinery, and dark secluded areas. For carpet beetles, treat infested areas of carpet, localized areas of floors, baseboards and into cracks and under carpets where these pests may be found. Spray 10-20 seconds per 100 sq.m of floor space. Repeat treatment weekly as insects appear.

COCKROACHES, SPIDERS, ANTS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, MILLIPEDES, SOWBUGS, PILLBUGS, AND CENTIPEDES: Hold aerosol close to cracks and mist directly into them, contacting as many insects as possible. Apply freely in all possible hiding places, behind baseboards, sinks, cabinets, coffee makers, meter boxes, manholes. Repeat all treatments as necessary. Insects must be contacted by insecticide to be killed.

FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Close windows and doors. Hold aerosol 100 cm above floor and direct fog toward floor and lower walls at rate of 10 seconds per 100 sq.m. Make sure that all floor, sofa, and chair surfaces, and animal sleeping quarters are contacted. Repeat treatment after 7 days.

BEDBUGS: Apply to bed frames, mattress buttons and seam beads, cracks and crevices in adjacent walls, floor areas, and furniture, baseboards and other areas where these pests may be present.

INJECTION SYSTEM: Replacing the atomizing mist nozzle (fogger nozzle) with the Injection System nozzle and injection tube, or attaching the aerosol to an Injection System Gun Assembly, allows for controlled applications in cracks and crevices. Place valve on the stem and press down lightly making sure tip is pointing away from face and body. Place injection system in cracks, crevices, holes, and other small openings and release approximately 1 second per spot for flushing and contact. Inject and spray all locations where the above insects may be a problem.

IN MEAT PACKAGING PLANTS AND FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS apply only when plant is not in operation by injecting into cracks and crevices and other locations where these insects may be a problem, contacting directly as many insects as possible. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. Cover all food processing surfaces prior to spraying. All food processing surfaces should be washed and rinsed thoroughly with potable water after spraying and before re-use for food processing.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND PETS. Do not remain in treated areas. Ensure proper ventilation after sealed areas have been treated. Do not use on Food. This product contains petroleum distillates and it may stretch and/or stain certain fabrics after its application. Prior to use of this product in areas where product may contact fabrics ie. carpets and furniture, spray a small hidden area of the fabric and let it dry to test for colour fastness and compatibility. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flames. Exposure to temperature over 50 deg C may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

Avoid inhalation of spray mist and skin contact. Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, ill or aged persons are confined.

FIRST AID: Flush contaminated eyes with plenty of water and get medical attention. If on skin, flush with clear water. If irritation persists, obtain medical attention. Wash contaminated clothing before re-use.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press valve to release all remaining pressure. Dispose of empty container in accordance with provincial requirements. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product and the cleanup of spills, contact the regional office of Environmental Protection, Environment Canada.
