DIRECTIONS FOR USE

USE LIMITATIONS: Use DITRAC Mouse Bait Station to control the house mouse (Mus musculus) in and around dwellings.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are

along walls, by gnawed openings, beside burrows, or in corners and concealed places.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS: HOUSE MICE: Place bait station at intervals of 2.5 to 3 meters along walls or in corners where mice live or travel. The bait station can be secured to the floor with a screw or double-sided tape. When bait is consumed, replace with one DITRAC BLOX.
