DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

GARDEN PESTS: Mix 50 mL of Diazinon 12.5% in 10 L of water. Spray plants thoroughly. Repeat as necessary.

INSECTS CONTROLLED: Aphids, caterpillars, leafminers, Colorado potato beetles, carrot rust fly, flea beetles, mealybugs, rose chafers, European pine shoot moth, fruit flies, mites (clover mites), scales, leafhoppers, thrips.

ORNAMENTALS: Arborvitae, boxwood, ivy, roses, azalea, carnations, oak, taxus, birch, chrysanthemums, juniper, crabapples, holly, pines.

FRUITS: Apples, cherries, peaches, plums, apricots, grapes, pears, strawberries.

VEGETABLES: Beans, carrots, lettuce, peppers, beets, cauliflower, onions, radishes, broccoli, celery, parsnips, spinach, cabbage, cucumber, potatoes, tomatoes.

CROP: (with days to harvest of last spray in brackets).

Tomatoes (1), Broccoli, Cauliflower (5), Strawberries, Peppers (5), Cabbage, Cucumbers, Snap Beans (7), Apples, Pears, Potatoes, Beets (14), Grapes (16), Peaches (20), All others (10).

LAWN INSECTS:

SPOT APPLICATION ONLY:

ANTS, SOD WEBWORMS (LAWN MOTHS) – mix 3.6 to 7.2 mL in 1 L of water. Apply 1 L per m² only in areas of infestation

CHINCHBUGS – mix 4.4 to 8.8 mL in 1 L of water. Apply 1 L per m². Use for spot treatment only in areas of infestation. Water lightly before and after application.

EARWIGS: Mix 53 mL per L of water. For spot treatment only in infested areas.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. May be fatal if swallowed. Wash hands thoroughly after use. Do not contaminate food or feed. Do not use or store near heat or flame. When applying to lawns wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes and socks and chemical resistant (e.g. rubber) gloves during handling, application and watering-in. Rinse gloves before removal. Do not treat areas greater than 450 m² (5000 ft²) in one day. Keep people off treated lawns for 24 hours following application and watering in.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, DO NOT induce vomiting. **If in eyes,** rinse with clear water. **If spilled on skin,** wash off immediately with soap and water. In case of accident call a doctor or Poison Control Centre immediately. Contains petroleum distillates. Take container, label or product name and P.C.P. Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Diazinon is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. This product contains petroleum distillates.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap empty container and discard with household garbage.
