Recommended Method for Sewer Lines that have Root Problems:

Residential 100mm Sewer Lines: Add entire contents of 454 g

bottle to the toilet bowl. Flush immediately to avoid foam

overflowing bowl. Restrict water usage from four to six hours.

Do not apply through sink or tub.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
