## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### Hazards to Humans

**CAUTION:** Causes eye burns and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Avoid contamination of food and food crops.
