#### DIRECTIONS

Before using ABF-100 industrial and commercial cooling tower systems must be cleaned to remove existing algae growth, bacterial slimes and other deposits. Then apply an initial dose of 0.5 to 1.0 litres of ABF-100 per 10,000 litres of recirculating water to provide a concentration of 50 to 100 ppm

of ABF-100. Repeat this initial dose until control is evident. Subsequent doses of 0.125 to 1.0 litres of ABF-100 (12.5 to 100 ppm of ABF-100) per 10,000 litres of water in the system, should be applied every 2 to 5 days or as needed. The frequency of dosage depends upon the relative rate of bleedoff and the severity of the microbiological contamination. The dosages should be introduced into the tower sump.

NOTICE TO THE USER: This control product is to be used only in accordance with the directions on the label. It is an offence under the Pest Control Products Act to use a control product under unsafe conditions.

PRECAUTIONS: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with the skin and eyes. Avoid contamination of food. This product is toxic to fish.
