DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply sufficient SANIBROM 40 BIOCID and an oxidant such as chlorine, sodium hypochlorite, or trichloro-s-triazinetrione to achieve a residual bromine level as needed to maintain control. A 0.5 to 2.0 mole ratio of sodium bromide to oxidant is recommended. Based on 1:1 mole ratio, 0.36 kg chlorine gas is recommended per litre of SANIBROM 40 BIOCID.

FIRST AID

IN CASE OF CONTACT WITH EYES OR SKIN: Flush thoroughly with water for 15 minutes. For eye contact, get medical attention. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

IF SWALLOWED: Drink two glasses of water. Call a physician or poison control center immediately.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air immediately. Call a physician or poison control center immediately.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
