DO NOT USE UNDILUTED.

"Sectrol" Insecticide may be applied as a GENERAL SURFACE SPRAY. Not for using undiluted

For General Treatment Control of: Fleas, cockroaches, ants, crickets, silverfish, firebrats, moths, flies, wasps, weevils, psocids, spiders, beetles, centipedes, mosquitoes

And Stored Product Pests: Granary weevils, rice weevils, confused flour beetles, red flour beetles, saw-toothed grain beetles, digarette beetles, drugstore beetles, dermestid beetles, Indian meal moths, Argoumois grain moth, Mediterranean flour moths, grain mites, dried fruit beetles, cadelles, mealworms.

Use Areas: Bakeries, beverage plants, canneries, dairies, flour mills, food processing plants, food storage areas, grain mills, meat packing plants, railroad cars, restaurants, supermarkets, truck trailers, warehouses, hospitals, hotels and motels, industrial installations, nursing homes, office buildings, residences, schools, kennels, zoos.

DILUTION INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Shake "Sectrol" concentrate well before diluting.
- 2. Dilute concentrate with water.

General Use: Add 19 parts water and 1 part concentrate to your spray bottle. At this dilution, this 200 mL bottle of concentrate will provide 1 treatment of an area of 100 sq. meters (1100 sq. ft.) Provide adequate ventilation during and after use. Keep pets and children away from surface until dry.

TO PROPERLY TREAT FOR FLEAS, FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Destroy or thoroughly clean your pet's bedding.
- Thoroughly clean and vacuum your home. Tightly seal vacuum bag and dispose in the garbage.
- 3. Shake diluted "Sectrol" Insecticide container vigorously for 15-20 seconds to

- disperse all the microcapsules before spraying.
- 4. Spray "Sectrol" Insecticide on any area that may be harbouring fleas. Pay special attention to cover pet resting areas and areas of frequent pet contact. Flooring, particularly carpets, should be sprayed thoroughly. Do not apply directly to pets.

NOTE: WE RECOMMEND PATCH TESTING CARPETS AND FURNITURE ON A HIDDEN AREA AND ALLOW THESE AREAS TO DRY BEFORE APPLICATION.

- 5. We recommend you limit vacuuming to high traffic areas for at least 30 days. Vacuumed areas should be lightly retreated to help ensure that the flea cycle is broken. "Sectrol" Insecticide has extended residual activity. The product continues working up to 30 days against fleas when the above instructions are followed.
- 6. Repeat application as needed.

"Sectrol" Insecticide does not leave an excessive residue. If sprayed to run-off, "Sectrol" Insecticide may be easily removed by wiping with a damp cloth or vacuuming.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- · Pyrethrin insecticides are hazardous to fish. Cover your aquarium.
- . "Sectrol" Insecticide products will not harm plants.
- "Sectrol" Insecticide products are virtually odourless. You do not have to leave your home after spraying.

EXPECTATIONS:

- How long does "Sectrol" Insecticide last? "Sectrol" Insecticide Premises
 Spray begins working upon drying (approximately 24 hours) and remains active up to 30 days.
- Which flea stages will "Sectrol" Insecticide kill? "Sectrol" Insecticide
 kills the adult flea only. Fleas lay hundreds of eggs that will hatch in a minimum
 of 3 weeks to 2 years
- 3. Are additional treatments of "Sectrol" Insecticide necessary? If fleas

take longer than 30 days to hatch, additional treatments of "Sectrol" Insecticide will be necessary. Repeated use of "Sectrol" Insecticide can be used in regions of heavy flea infestation as a control measure.

- 4. Will fleas die immediately after spraying? "Sectrol" Insecticide capsules are inactive when wet. It may take 24-48 hours to see a significant reduction in the flea population. Once the flea picks up a significant number of dry "Sectrol" Insecticide capsules, it will die within hours. The flea will become noticeably sluoish before death.
- Will new fleas be seen in the home over the 30-day period? In severe
 cases, new outbreaks may occur. This is a result of egg hatching. This new
 outbreak will be controlled by "Sectrol" Insecticide.

FOR BEST RESULTS

- 1. Follow all instructions carefully.
- Keep your pet and home treated throughout flea season if necessary to prevent reinfestation from outdoors.
- "Sectrol" Insecticide may be applied as a GENERAL SURFACE SPRAY. Direct this spray onto floors, walls, into hiding places, moist areas, harbourage areas, under pallets, around containers of stored food, around the base of machinery, behind shelves and drawers and on or around insect entry areas. Spray directly on insects where possible.

Food Areas: In meat packing and food processing plants, and food service establishments, only spray when plant is not in operation. No exposed meat products, ingredients or packaging materials to be left in the room and cover food handling equipment. Any treated surface that may contact meat food products or other food products should be washed and rinsed thoroughly with potable water after spraying and before re-use for food processing.

Non-Food Areas: Treat garbage rooms, lavatories, offices, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, closets and storage areas. Spray baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, tables, cabinets, pallets, and other areas where insects hide or through which they may enter. Repeat treatment as necessary.
