PREMIUM EMULSIBLE DORMANT SPRAY OIL is an emulsifiable type of mineral oil for use in control of insect pests attacking apples, peaches, pears, plums and cherries.

Mixing **PREMIUM** Emulsible Dormant Spray Oil with sulphur compounds may reduce emulsification. Crop / To Control:

Apples, Pears / San Jose Scale, Lecanium Scale Peaches / Overwintering, Leaf Roller (eggs) Plums, Cherries / European Red Mite Pear / Psylla

Rate/Time: Use 40 Litres of PREMIUM Dormant Spray Oil Per 1000 Litres of water or use 90 litres per hectare. Make a single application per season when trees are in the dormant stage.

To prevent damage to plant life apply only under proper conditions. Avoid spraying during or just prior to freezing weather, rain or other unsuitable weather conditions. While thorough coverage is important, avoid over spraying. Plants should be sprayed only when in a healthy condition and use efficient spraying equipment. Do not use when water temperatures are below 4.4°C. Government Agricultural Authorities upon consultation will give you specific instructions as to the use of dormant type oil sprays.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:

Be certain the spray tank is clean. To mix, add water to the level of the agitator shaft and with agitator in motion pour in the required amount of PREMIUM Emulsible Dormant Spray Oil. The mixture should turn white which indicates good emulsification. After mixing continue filling the tank and do not stop agitation until contents have been sprayed out entirely.
