DIRECTION FOR USE:

READ THE ENTIRE LABEL FIRST.

Follow all use directions and precautions carefully. Do not use this product for uses other than those listed on this label. Only use treated garment when mosquitoes are a problem. Shake well before using to completely emulsify the product. Wear chemical gloves when using this product. To be used only as treatment for 100% cotton-mesh greige HorseAround™ Clothing products. Adjust the trigger spray nozzle to deliver a fine spray and apply to any of the HorseAround™ garments when mosquitoes first become a nuisance. To apply, hang the untreated garments outside or in a well ventilated area and back them with a piece of thin plastic sheeting. Spray the OUTSIDE of each garment using a steady back and forth motion to ensure an even coverage to the entire area. 631 mL (2/3 of container) is required to treat either the HorseAround™ Stable Sheet or Riding Sheet. 315 mL (1/3 of a container) is required to treat the HorseAround™ Headpiece. The garment is ready to use when dry. Protection extends to all areas of the horse covered by a treated garment. Uncovered areas of the horse are not protected by treated HorseAround™ garments. Unprotected areas of the horse may need to be treated by a repellent or insecticide registered for horses. To prolong the effectiveness of the garment when not in use, seal in a plastic bag and store in a cold, dry place. After 7 weeks, if the effectiveness has decreased, wash the garment in warm water and detergent separate from other clothing before treating. Do not launder garments between treatments. Do not repeat application more often than once every seven weeks.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. DO NOT TREAT ANIMALS DIRECTLY WITH THIS PRODUCT. Harmful if swallowed, in eyes, inhaled or on skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after use. Avoid inhaling vapor or spray mist. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. POTENTIAL SKIN SENSITIZER, Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic skin reaction in some individuals. Not for use on humans. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If inhaled, remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention immediately. If in eyes, flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. Take container, label or product and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Treat symptomatically: if in eyes, can cause temporary irritation, tearing and blurred vision, if on skin, can cause mild irritation. Prolonged or repeated exposure can progress into dermatitis. Excessive inhalation can cause nasal and respiratory irritation, headache and dizziness. CONTAINS PETROLEUM DISTILLATE, ingestion can cause stomach irritation, resulting in nausea, cramps, and vomiting; may cause fatigue, dizziness, headaches, lack of coordination, tremors or unconsciousness.
