Apply to turf or to soil around plants at a rate of 400 g per 10 m2. Make no more than 2 applications per season.

CUTWORMS, ROOT MAGGOTS - Apply if damage is expected. Use on broccoli, Brussel sprouts, cabbage, Chinese cabbage, cauliflower, carrots, celery, cucumbers, green peppers, onions, potatoes, sweet corn and tomatoes. Apply at 200 g per 10 m2 of soil surface before planting or transplantation. Do not make more than one application per year. Rake soil lightly to incorporate granules into top 5 cm of soil. Do not use on green bunching onions.
