A-33 is a disinfectant/detergent/fungicide/mildewcide/virucide/ odour counteractant. Intended for use on environmental surfaces and equipment in hospitals, nursing homes and related institutions. Recommended for cleaning and disinfecting surfaces and equipment in food/beverage processing, preparation and service institutions. Also for use in retail, manufacturing educational and recreational facilities.

At a dilution of 12ml/L, A-33 is effective against:

As a disinfectant:

Escherichia coli	Klebsiella Pneumoniae,
Proteus vulgaris	Pseudomonas aeruginosa
Shigella flexneri	Serratia marcescens
Salmonella cholerasuis	Staphylococcus aureus

as a fungicide: kills Trichophyton interdigitale (Athlete's foot fungus) and Candida albicans

as a mildewcide: controls Aspergillus niger

as a virucide: kills influenza A2 (aichi), parainfluenza 1 (Sendai), canine distemper, feline pneumonitis, Herpes simplex 1

DIRECTIONS:

Prepare an accurate dilution of 12 mL/L in hot or cold water. Apply solution with mop, sponge, cloth or sprayer. Allow 10 minutes contact wet time. Remove solution or suspend soil with clean wet mop, sponge, cloth or wet vacuum pickup.

A-33 at a dilution of 12 mL/L kills the Human Immunodeficient Virus (HIV) on hard non-porous surfaces.

Personal Protection: When handling items soiled with blood or body fluids wear personal protection such as disposable latex gloves, gowns, masks or eye protection.

Cleaning Procedures: Blood and other body fluids must be thoroughly cleaned from surfaces and objects before application of disinfectant solution.
