DIRECTIONS: Apply dry or as a spray for general vegetation control. For all uses, uniform application is essential. To

minimize fire hazard due to dry vegetation, treatment while weeds are small is suggested.

Co-op Total Vegetation Control Granules will give quick knockdown of vegetation and residual control of broad-leaved weeds and grasses on patios, parking lots fence lines and other similar areas where undesirable growth occurs.

SPRAY APPLICATION: For young growth up to 15 cm high, add .5-1 kg of product to sufficient water to cover $10~\text{m}^2$. Apply as contact spray, thoroughly wetting all parts of plants, particularly the growing tips. 3-5 litres per $10~\text{m}^2$ is usually adequate for young growth. The higher rate may be necessary to ensure thorough coverage of heavy vegetation.

DRY GRANULES TREATMENT: Apply .5 - 1 kg per 10 m^2 . The lighter rate should be used only at time of weed emergence on moist soil or when precipitation is anticipated while weeds are still young.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Co-op Total Vegetation Control as received is not flammable. To avoid possible fire hazard from dead and dry vegetation, apply when weeds and grasses are not over a few centimetres high. Care should be taken to avoid its contact with lawns, trees, shrubs, crops and other desirable plants which are not intended to be destroyed or injured. This includes precaution in treating areas which may be underlaid by roots of adjacent valuable growth.
