#### INSTRUCTIONS

Algae are microscopic plant like organisms which grow in the water and thrive on sunlight. When allowed to grow in pool water, algae will give the water a greenish or brownish haze and if not controlled will give a slippery feel to the walls and bottom of the pool.

By controlling algae growth with CHEMEX ALGAECIDE it may be possible to use significantly less chlorine than would otherwise be required.

#### DIRECTIONS

POOL START UP: To kill and control visible algae most commonly found in swimming pools add 1.5 litres of CHEMEX ALGAECIDE per 10,000 litres of water. Vacuum any dead algae away.

MAINTENANCE-CONTROL: When existing growth is dead and withered algae has been vacuumed away, inhibit algae growth by adding 325 ml of CHEMEX ALGAECIDE per 10,000 litres of water once every week.

#### PRECAUTIONS

1. Keep out of reach of children

2. Avoid contact with skin and eyes
3. Avoid contamination of food
4. Do not mix with other pool chemicals
5. Add directly to pool
6. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it
