DIRECTIONS

Place DIPHACIN BLOCKS in location where rats and mice are accustomed to feed, travel, drink or live. Place bait in

secluded corners, along walls, under cover where rats and mice feel safe to feed. RATS: Break and place 8 to 16 DIPHACIN BLOCK segments in areas where rats are accustomed to feed unobserved. Assure an uninterrupted supply for a period of not less than 15 days and continue baiting until all signs of feeding have stopped. MICE: Break DIPHACIN BLOCKS into segments and place at 1.5 to 3 m intervals where mice are active. Assure an uninterrupted supply for a period of not less than 15 days.

PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Baits must be placed in areas not accessible to children, pets, wildlife and domestic animals or placed in tamperproof bait boxes. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wash arms, hands and face with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. IF SWALLOWED by humans, pets, wildlife or domestic animals, this material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding.

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED, give patient 1 - 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by inserting finger down throat, repeat until fluid is clear. Call a physician or contact a poison control centre.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Vitamin K, in the form of intravenous, intramuscular or subcutaneous injections, or by oral ingestion are suggested remedial treatments for anticoagulant poisoning. The severity of the case measured by establishing prolonged prothrombin times (P.T.) will determine appropriate therapy. Monitoring P.T. will indicate the necessity of repeated treatments.

DISPOSAL

Dispose of empty container in household garbage. Dispose of any exposed dead rodents, unused and stale bait in accordance with local requirements.
