DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For manufacturing use only. Formulators are responsible for their own registrations under the Pest Control Products Act.

PRECAUTIONS:

FATAL IF SWALLOWED OR INHALED. CORROSIVE. CAUSES IRREVERSIBLE EYE DAMAGE AND SEVERE SKIN BURNS.

Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear full-face protection, coveralls, chemical-resistant boots when handling the concentrate. Wash hands and face before eating, drinking, smoking and using the toilet. Change clothing daily. Wash contaminated clothing separately from household laundry.

FIRST AID:

<u>Skin Contact:</u> Remove contaminated clothing. Flush affected areas immediately with flowing water for at least 15 minutes. Get prompt medical attention if the skin becomes inflamed.

<u>Eye Contact</u>: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes, occasionally lifting the upper and lower lids. Get medical attention.

<u>Inhalation:</u> Immediately remove the exposed person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if breathing has stopped (do not use mouth to mouth method). Keep the affected person warm and quiet. Get immediate medical attention.

<u>Ingestion</u>: Promptly drink a large quantity of milk, egg whites or gelatin solution. If these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Never give liquid to an unconscious person.

Call an industrial physician or poison control centre immediately for subsequent advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:

Toxic to fish. Do not flush liquid wastes into streams or other surface water.
