DIRECTIONS:

WASH APPLICATION

Mix 60 grams of Co-op Warble Powder per litre of water. Apply 8 litres to 25-35 animals, depending on size, thickness of coat and infestation. Apply the mixture with a brush to the backs of the animals. Brush in well, break scabs that may have formed over the air holes in skin. Apply three treatments as recommended below. Add the powder to a small amount of water to make a creamy mix. Then dilute to the required volume.

SPRAY APPLICATION

Mix 1 kg of Co-op Warble Powder in 100 litres of water. Treat each animal with four litres in a strip 60 cm wide along the back bone. Use a high pressure sprayer with a nozzle pressure of 3000 kPa. Hold nozzle 25 cm from animal's skin. Apply at an angle between 60EC-90EC

to the skin surface.

WHEN TO APPLY

In Western Canada: Apply when scabs first form, usually about March 1st. Make two more applications leaving 22-27 days between treatments.

In Eastern Canada: Apply when scabs first form, usually about March 1st. Make two more applications leaving 22-27 days between treatment.

PRECAUTIONS: Keep out of reach of children.

May be harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing dust or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash after handling and before eating, drinking or smoking.
